



## 2025 Continuing Education Requirements

**A total of twenty (20) hours of Continuing Education credits are required annually. Twelve (12) hours of non-face-to-face Continuing Education credits will be accepted in any category except CPR. Eight (8) hours of Continuing Education credits must be in-person. Refer to Rules 4.1 and 4.2 for additional information.**

<b>Practice Management</b>	Maximum of four (4) hours	Maximum of four (4) hours
<b>Therapeutic Treatment</b>	Minimum of ten (10) hours	Minimum of ten (10) hours
<b>Performance of Primary Eyecare Procedures</b>	N/A	Six (6) hours

\* All PEP certified optometrists must file a YAG Performance Report by January of each year. All primary eyecare procedures must be performed inside the office location on file with the Board of Optometry office.
